#### **Events of the Year**

#### **Students' Orientation**

The IQAC organised a Student Orientation on the 18<sup>th</sup> of July as an initiation for the freshers to get acquainted with the goals and objectives of the institution and its functioning mode and what is expected of them and from their caregivers. This programme had medical practitioners as chief guests. Practising psychiatrists, Dr. Poornajith M.D. and Dr. Ramesh M.D., addressed the students on the challenges of student life, the road that lay ahead of them and about the role of parents.

# **Students Induction Programme**

The IQAC organised a week-long Induction Programme from the 19<sup>th</sup> of July to the 27<sup>th</sup> of July, through the Department of English of the College, where students were introduced to the system of regular functioning of the institution and to have a firsthand experience of college life through this interactive and participative programme. J., Principal as the Resource Person. Principal's motivational, self-introspective talk was followed by a session addressed by Dr. Savidha R. on the NAAC manual and its essential requirements titled as "An Outline of NAAC Accreditation Framework".

An MoU was signed by the principals of both institutions in this regard. A detailed discussion on the above collaboration happened between the HoDs and the IQAC members of both the colleges.

# **Extended IQAC Committee Meeting**

Extended IQAC committee meeting was organised on 2<sup>nd</sup>, February 2023, during which the external members and well-wishers shared and discussed their role in the welfare of the institution. They had an interaction with a number of students picked at random from different departments in this regard. The main objective was the skill development programmes and the student support provided by the college. The ideas and suggestions shared by the external members were noted for analysis and will be implemented for further progress.

# **IQAC Team visited Government Arts College Coimbatore (Autonomous)**

#### **NIRF Seminar**

The IQAC organised a One Day Seminar titled, "NIRF Goal Post - Methodologies and Attainment" for the staff and selected nodal officers from each department to work towards the NIRF ranking of the institution. Dr. N. Kavitha, Nodal Officer for NIRF from Nehru College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore was the resource person. The resource person introduced us to the respective modes of calculation followed for the NIRF ranking of HEIs and its corresponding formulas which were beneficial.

### **External Academic Audit (Best Practice of the Year)**

As an essential step from the IQAC to maintain academic standard, an External Academic Audit was conducted for the departments. Academic audit is a tool to estimate the adequacy of academic inputs and to enhance the quality of each department's programmes. The academic audit has helped improve useful practices such as upgradation of syllabus, restructuring of the website to highlight the accomplishments of the institution and the skill development programmes.
