

OZONE DAY CELEBRATION (2022- 2023)



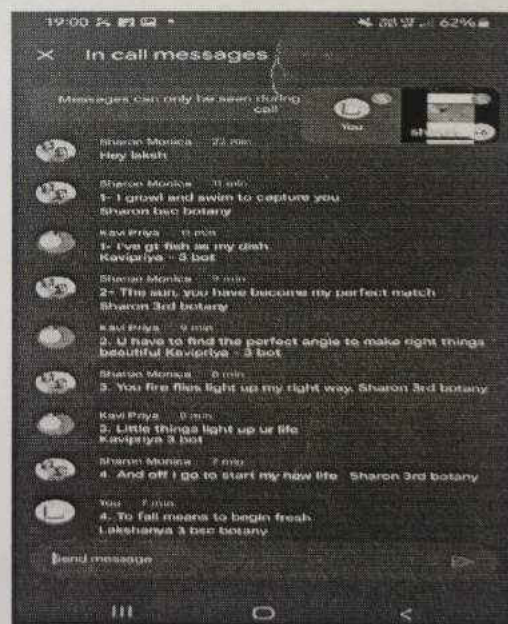
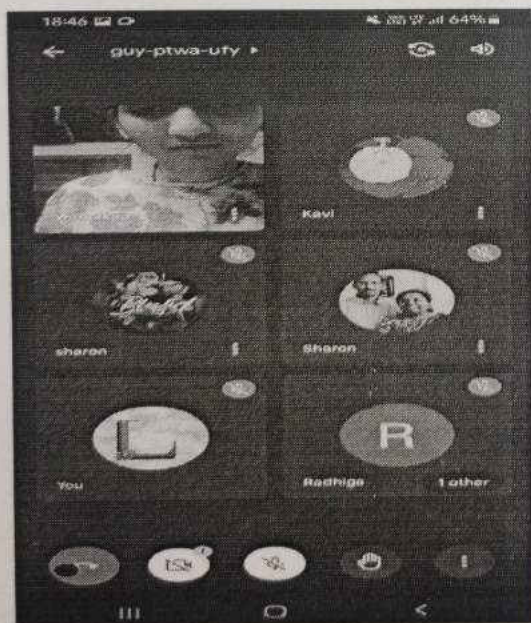
DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY WORLD WILDLIFE WEEK CELEBRATION (2022-2023)

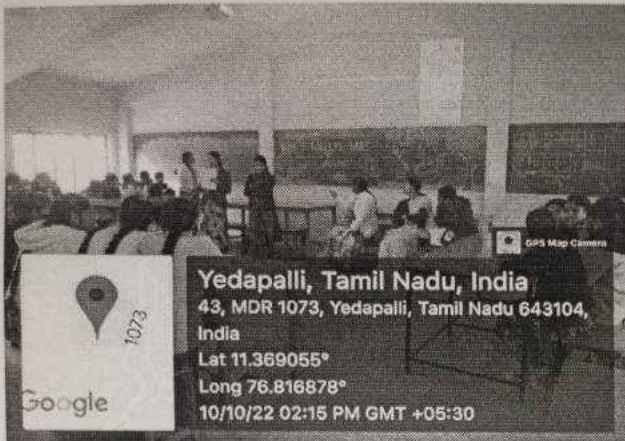
1. Caption it (Captioning the given photograph) competition (Online) on 02.10.2022

Many students actively participated. It was very useful to bring out the different talent of the young generation.

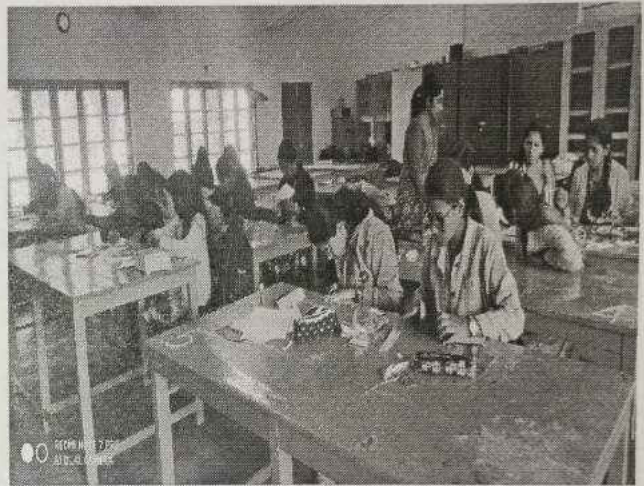
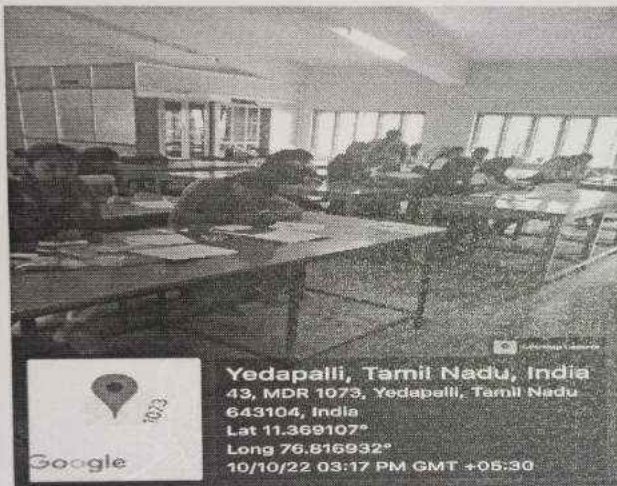
