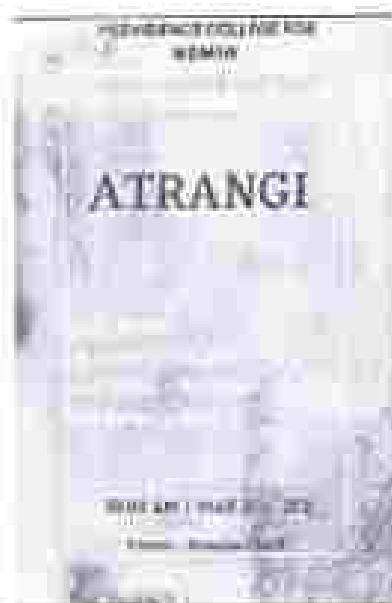

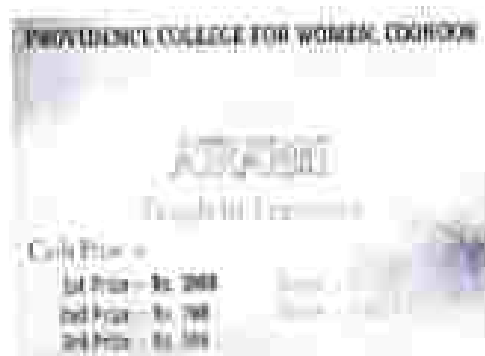
TRASH TO TREASURE

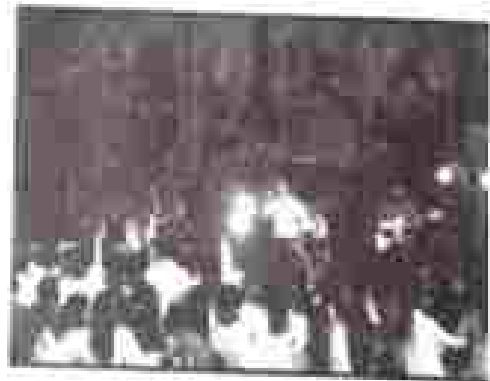

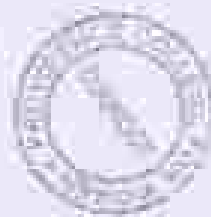
