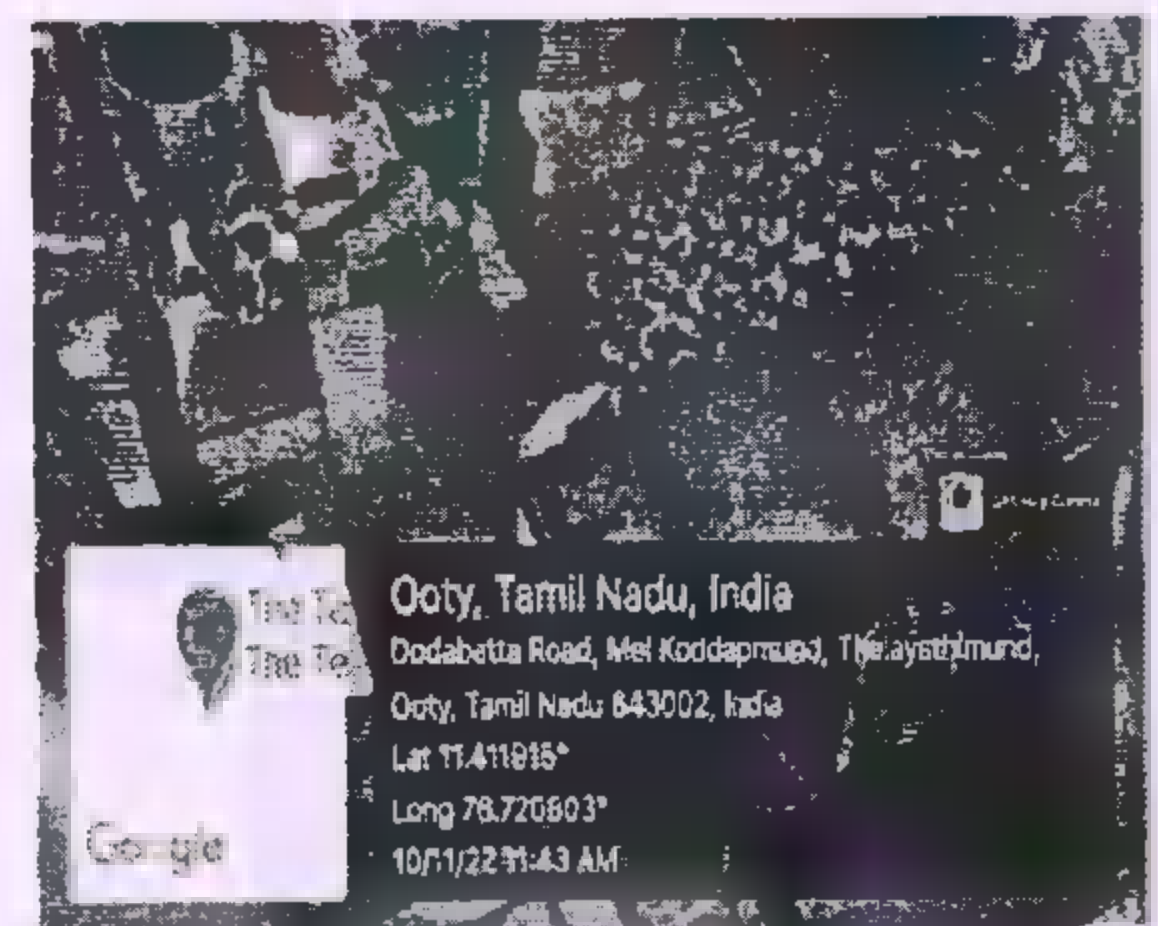
INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO DODDABETTA TEA FACTORY AND TEA MUSEUM

They also went around the Chocolate Factory and chocolate marketing center. They witnessed the marketing of quality leather products, woolen garments and spices.







Students visit to Tea Factory

Department of Botany-Institutional / Field Trip (18.10.2022)


The Department of Botany made a field trip and Institutional visit on 18.10.2022. A group of 22 students from III B.Sc. and 4 students from II M.Sc. accompanied by four staff members (Dr.N.Visalakshi, Associate Professor & Head, Mrs.C.Praveena, Asst. Prof., Ms.P.Saranya, Asst. Prof. and Mrs.Rebeka Jacintha, Lab Assistant) from Department of Botany visited the Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding (IFGTB), Forest Campus, Coimbatore, wherein they were explained about the significance of herbaria in Taxonomy, Typification and about the need of digital herbaria in today's scenario including the APG classification. They were shown many herbaria from the collections of the renowned Taxonomists from 1817 till the recent day. After that they were taken to IFGTB - Gass museum where they spent an hour and learnt about various types of botanical specimens, Pteridophytes, Fungi, Gymnosperms, ethnobotanical materials, different varieties of wood including Dendrochronology. They also saw some zoological specimens like varieties of butterflies, wonderful collections of birds, animals including the foetus of Gaur, elephant, monkeys, varieties of reptiles, weapons used in army force, different types of dresses and ornaments used by various tribes of India, various medicinal products from plants, animals and their products etc.


After visiting IFGTB they were taken to the Botanical Survey of India (BSI), Southern circle, Coimbatore where again they were shown herbarium specimens and a documentary on BSI, Botanical garden-as source of Taxonomic literature and the establishment and circles of BSI.

In the afternoon after finishing the Institutional visit, they were taken for a field trip to Marudhamalai Scrub Forest, which a type of tropical Dry Ever Green Forest. They learnt about several thorny species and also some medicinal plants like *Albizia*, *Acacia*, *Cardiopermum*, *Carissa carandus*, *Zizyphus*, *Manilkara*, *Anisomelos* etc.

The visit was very informative and motivating as they could get lot of information regarding various aspects of Botany and also as they could interact with many Research scholars in both the places.




