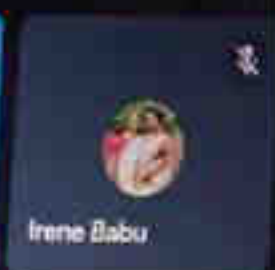

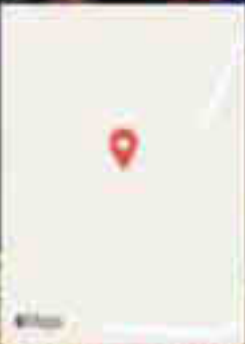


Discussion on Sex Trafficking

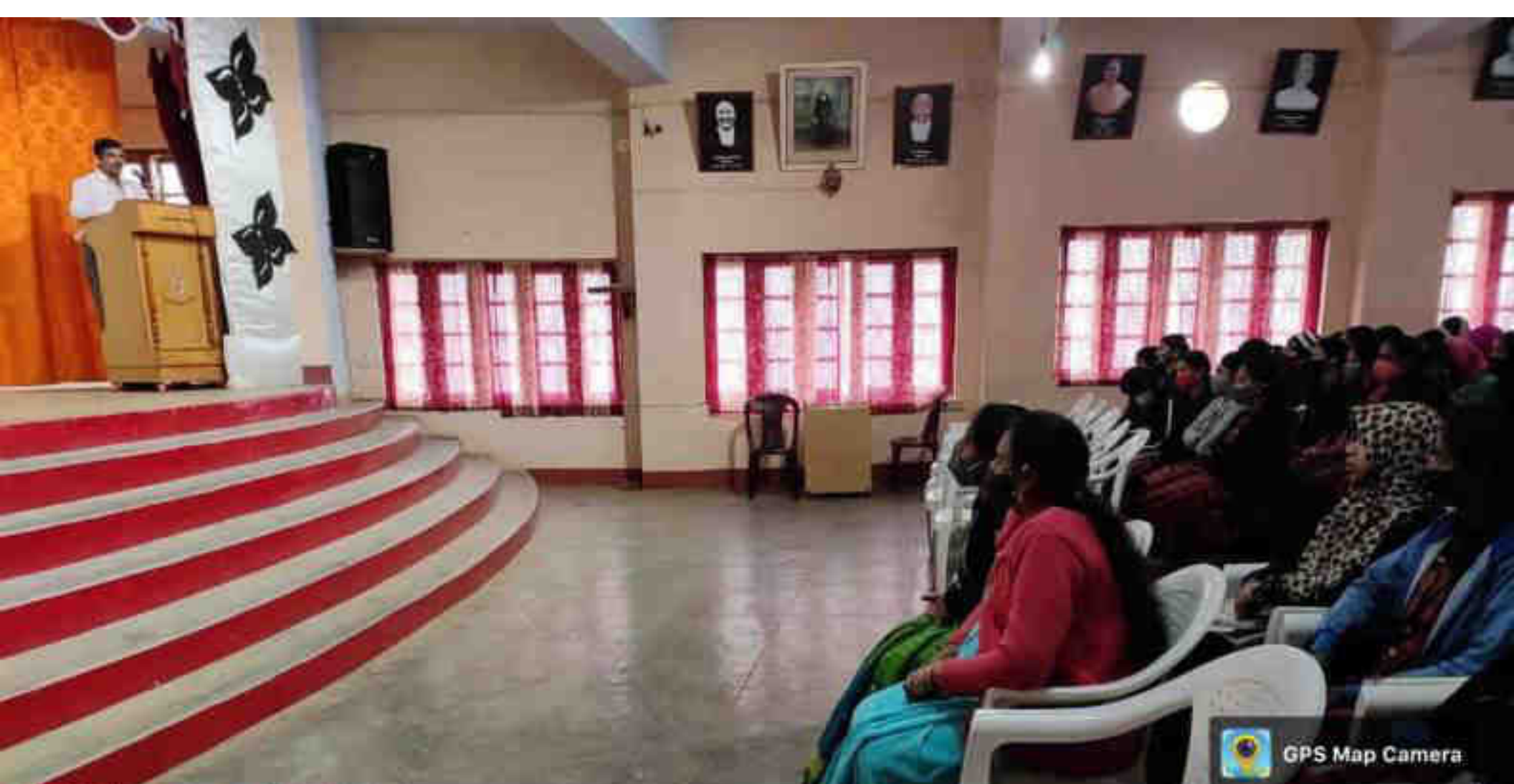


