

REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE NSS (Unit I and II) FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-2018

The activities of the NSS for the year 2017-2018 began with the election of the office bearers. The following students were elected as new office bearers.

Following are the activities for the year 2017-2018:

On 1st July 2017, an orientation was given to the first year students by Dr. Amudha R, Assistant Professor, Dept of English and Mrs Sashirekha B, Assistant Professor in Commerce regarding the significance of NSS and the role of students in NSS activities.

As part of the regular activities of NSS, the students clean the campus regularly on Tuesdays and Thursdays and during important programmes of the college.

On 6th July 2017, Yoga demonstration programme was organized in the college. The resource person Mrs. Sumathi explained the significance of yoga practice in our day to day lives and demonstrated some of the asanas.

On 27th July 2017, to commemorate Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam's anniversary, a rally was organized from Bedford to Coonoor and our students participated in the rally.

On 17th August 2017, An awareness rally on "Plastic Free Campus" was organized by NSS, Rotaract club and Eco Club of our college. The rally was started from our college premises upto Bandishola Village School. Our students and the school children conducted awareness skits and programmes in the school campus. Special talks were delivered by resource person in the NSS garden.

On 26th August 2017, NSS students of our college participated in the Breast Cancer Awareness Programme sponsored by Ramakrishna Hospital, Coimbatore and distributed pamphlets to the nearby villages.

In commemoration of "World Rabies Day" on 28th September 2017, a rally was organized by Pasteur Institute, Sims Park and the NSS volunteers of our college participated in the rally.

The NSS Volunteers of our college along with the staff conducted Dengue Awareness Programme in Kolacombai, Hulical village and Non-Such Tea estate on 23rd and 24th October 2017.

An Orientation on cleanliness and Dengue fever was given to the college students by Mr. L. Ramachandran, Block Health Supervisor and Mr. B. M. Devaraj, Health Inspector on 25th October 2017.

On 26th October 2017, the NSS volunteers conducted an awareness programme on Dengue fever for the Government school children in Bandishola.

On 27th October 2017, the NSS students along with Coonoor municipality prepared Nilavembu Kashayam and it was given to the staff and students of our college to drink as a prevention measure for Dengue. A medical camp was organized by the doctors of Lawley hospital to diagnose Dengue fever for the staff and students of our college.

A Special Camp was conducted in Bandishola and Amman Nagar from 15th December 2017 to 21st December 2017.

On 22nd January 2018, a rally was organized by the Thasildar, Coonoor regarding Voters Day and our NSS students participated in the rally in Coonoor and signature campaign was also held before the rally.

On Republic Day, 26th January 2018, the NSS volunteers performed a dance on patriotism. On the same day a rally was organized by Nethaji Navabarath Foundation to honour the freedom fighters. The national flag was hoisted at Coonoor Bus stop. Our NSS students participated in the rally. This was followed by cultural programmes in St. Sebastian's Church.
